

- 200 bed Eye Hospital with tertiary care facilities.
- Capital cost of building including furniture and fixtures (5000 sq m, 50,000 sq ft): Rs. 20 Crores.
- Cost of Specialist equipment: Rs 4.5 Crores.
- Operating cost: Approximately Rs 4000 per Cataract surgery including cost of rural outreach, transportation, surgery, rehabilitation and review.
