Message of Blessings

Adi Sankara has authored many books – ‘KanakadharaStotram’ in the field of Bhakti, ‘Bhaja Govindam’, ‘Prasnottara Ratnamalika’ for Niti (ethics), and Prakarana Granthas where he has explained Vedanta as if in the form of a Kavya (epic). In the Bhashyas of Vedanta works, he has written in the form of many questions and answers, where he raises many arguments and doubts and resolves all of them, in a manner even those outside of this tradition can understand. He has also penned other works like ‘Prapancha Saram’ for Mantra Sastra, and commentary for ‘Aapastamba Dharma Sutra’. ‘Harimeede’ Stotra is one of his works.

Commentary is required to understand the lofty thoughts in this Stotra. Adi Sankara united our countrymen, who are divided by language, through bhakti and love. Though there are many philosophies like Vaishnavism, Shaktam, Yoga, Sankhya etc., it was Adi Sankara who showed us what to grasp from each of them. He established the foundation of Astikam. He explained the qualities of unity, love and peace through Sastras. Were it not for him, we could not have experienced unity and peace today. It is his grace that has kept us as Sanatanists.

To understand our Dharma, it is better to learn that through Samskrit. When we learn it through the medium of ten people, there is a chance of our understanding going wrong. We should learn ourselves through Samskrit, Tamil or English. Vedanta means the final conclusion of Veda. In Tamil it is said, ‘Never shall you spend a day without chanting Veda’; in Samskrit, Adi Sankara has said, ‘वेदो नित्यमधीयताम्’. The meaning of Stotras etc. is easy to comprehend; but Veda is tough. Viewing what is said at the beginning, middle and end, meaning has to be inferred. Religious Works, which are in the form of palm leaves, should be published in book form for which enthusiasm, interest and devotion are required. We should spend money for dharma, as we are spending on other things.

There is opportunity to attain Gnana, if we try with Dhyana (contemplation) and patience; if not, Gnana cannot be attained even in many births, as in ‘Punarapi Jananam’. There is no need to search outside what is right inside us. We bless that by the grace of Acharya, all should get the fortune to be of service.



The Divine Dialogue between Sage Yajnavalkya and Maitreyi

An introduction to the Brihadāraṇyaka Upanishad

Among the four Vedas, the *Yajurveda* shines with two divisions — the *Shukla (White)* *Yajurveda* and the *Krishna (Black)* *Yajurveda*. Each Veda, in general, has four integral parts:

1. **Samhita** – the hymns and mantras,
2. **Brahmana** – explanations of the rituals and karmas,
3. **Aranyaka** – meditations and spiritual practices, and
4. **Upanishad** – the section of pure knowledge that unveils the Self.



While the Upanishads are independent revelations, some find place within the *Samhita*, and others within the *Aranyaka*. For instance, the *Isha Upanishad* belongs to the *Samhita* of the Shukla *Yajurveda*, whereas the *Brihadaranyaka Upanishad* belongs to its *Aranyaka*. Hence, the former is called a *Sahitopanishad*, and the latter, an *Aranyakopanishad*.

The *Brihadaranyaka Upanishad* — literally meaning “*The Great Forest Teaching*” — is vast and profound, the largest of all Upanishads. The entire Shukla *Yajurveda*, which encompasses the *Samhita*, *Brahmana*, *Aranyaka*, and *Upanishad*, is said to be the manifestation of *Brahmavidya* — the Supreme Knowledge — revealed to Sage Yājñavalkya by the grace of the Sun God.

This Upanishad consists of six chapters.

- The **first and second** expound on *Brahmavidya*, describing the *Ananda-svarupa Parabrahman* — the Supreme Reality whose nature is Bliss. These two are together known as the *Madhu-Kanda* (“The Honey Section”), for they describe the sweetness of that eternal essence.
- The **third and fourth** chapters unfold as a series of deep dialogues and debates led by Sage Yājñavalkya, presenting the same truth through reasoning and insight. Hence, they are known as the *Yājñavalkya-Kanda*.
- The **fifth and sixth** chapters guide aspirants of varying capacities through worship, meditation, and moral conduct, serving as a supplement called the *Khil-Kanda* or appendix.

Śrī Vidyāranya, in his commentary, further classified these into three sections:

- *Upadesha-Kanda* (Instruction – Madhu),
- *Upapatti-Kanda* (Reasoning – Yājñavalkya), and
- *Upasana-Kanda* (Worship – Khil).

In the very first section — the *Madhu-Kanda* — occurs the luminous Dialogue between Yājñavalkya and Maitreyī, a conversation so exalted that it is repeated almost verbatim again in the *Yājñavalkya-Kanda*. Such repetition in a sacred text of this stature is rare and signifies profound importance.

In the first instance, Yājñavalkya imparts the *teaching* of Brahman — the eternal truth as revealed through realization. In the second, the same teaching is *contemplated* and *affirmed* through reason, symbolizing the journey from understanding to conviction.

Thus, the dialogue stands as both the seed and the fruit of the *Brihadaranyaka Upanishad* — the essence of all Upanishadic wisdom. It distills the nectar of *Brahmavidya*, the knowledge of the Self that alone grants immortality.

In the quiet dawn of ancient India, when knowledge was not written but realized, two luminous souls met in dialogue — Sage Yājñavalkya, the seer of truth, and his wife Maitreyī, a seeker whose questions pierced the very heart of existence. Their conversation, preserved in the *Brihadāraṇyaka Upanishad*, remains one of humanity's most profound explorations of love, renunciation, and the nature of immortality.

When Yājñavalkya prepares to renounce worldly life, he offers his wealth to Maitreyī. Yet Maitreyī, unmoved by riches, asks a question that resounds through the ages:

“If all the wealth in the world cannot make me immortal, what use is it to me?”

In that moment, the ordinary becomes divine. Yājñavalkya reveals that immortality is not attained through possessions, but through Self-realization — through knowing that the Ātman, the Self within, is one with the infinite.

Their dialogue transcends the roles of husband and wife; it becomes the meeting of wisdom and wonder, knowledge and yearning. It is an invitation to every seeker to look inward and discover that which cannot perish — the boundless consciousness that is our true essence.

We offer this sacred conversation — radiant, pure, and timeless — to our readers. May we bow in reverence at the holy feet of Sage Yājñavalkya and the noble seeker Maitreyī, and may their grace illumine our minds with the light of Self-knowledge — the sweet and immortal *Madhu* of the Upanishads.

We share this prelude to the immortal dialogue between Sage Yājñavalkya and the noble Maitreyī — a conversation that distills the very essence of the Upanishads and shines as the crown jewel of the *Brihadāraṇyaka Upanishad*. In the editions to come, we shall journey deeper into their profound exchange — exploring the timeless truths it reveals about love, renunciation, and the realization of the Self.

Later in a function held at Kanchi Math Tent at Sector 20, Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh Sri Yogi Adityanath participated and honoured Acharya Swamigal. The Purnahuti for Rudra Yagnya was performed at the Yagashala on his arrival.

Earlier in the day, following State Guest protocol norms, Acharya Swamigal was received by UP Government officials right on arrival at 11:30 at Prayagraj Airport and accompanied the entire till departure at 8PM. In midst of unimaginable crowd, the officials ensured a remarkably smooth visit.

Speaking on various occasions, Acharya Swamigal commended the faith, patience and resilience of common people, the greatness of Sanatan Dharma, the significance of Kumbh Mela and the efforts of state and central governments.

Devotees participated in large numbers in the visit of Acharya Swamigal.

With the blessings of Acharya Swamigal, the Kanchi Math had set up a special tent in sector 20 to conduct Veda Parayanams, Havans, Pravachans, Cultural programmes and to felicitate facilities for devotees visiting Prayagraj from South.

Praying for welfare of one & all, Veda Parayanam by Chitrakoot, Lucknow, Kashi & Ayodhya Pathashalas run by Kanchi Math, Special Shanmata Havans by Vaidika team from Chennai, Rigveda Havan by Scholars from Mumbai & Chennai, Rudra Havan & Durga Havan, Samuhika Stotra Parayanam by more than 100 Kamakoti Adhyapika (women), Durga Saptashati Yagnya, Annadana, Bhagavath Pravachan by Swami Govind Dev Giriji Maharaj were held at Shri Kanchi Math tent continuously for the entire Kumbh Mela period. Despite the constraints of crowd and other conditions, Scholars, Pathashala Students, Organisers, volunteers gave their best efforts to carry the directions of Acharya Swamigal. 
Pujya Shankaracharya inaugurates Viswanatha Dhyana Mandiram at NSU, Tirupati (11-Apr-2025)

Sanyasa Sweekara Mahotsavam performed on the auspicious Akshaya Triteya (30-Apr-2025)

Acharya Swamigal gave Sanyasa Deeksha to Sri Duddu Satya Venkata Surya Subrahmanya Ganesha Sharma Dravid at Shri Kamakshi Ambal Devasthanam in Kanchipuram on the banks of the Pancha-Ganga pond in the early hours of 30th April - the auspicious day of Budha (ବୁଦ୍ଧ) - Rohini- Akshaya Triteya. The new Acharya was given the deeksha name as 'Satya Chandrashekarendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamiji'.

The pre-sanyasa rituals commenced early at around 5 am. Acharya Swamigal walked from Shrimatam and arrived at the Kamakshi temple around 5.30, accompanied by mangala vadyam, vedic chanting and devotees. A grand reception was accorded with Poornakumbham at the temple entrance, and the skies of Kanchi reverberated with the sound and lights of crackers.

The stage was set at the Mangala Vinayaka Sannidhi on the banks of Pancha-Ganga teertham in Kamakshi temple. Acharya Swamigal arrived at the stage and the Sanyasa Sweekarana Mahotsavam commenced. Sri Ganesha Sharma Dravid, had Snanam in Pancha-Ganga teertham, and amidst recitations of mantras for renunciation was blessed with Kashaya vastra, Danda, Kamandala, Asana and was given Mahavakya upadesha by Acharya Swamigal. A Sudarsana Salagrama was placed on the young Swamiji's head and abhishekam was performed with a conch. Acharya Swamigal then gave a powerful message to all of the world in 5 different languages and blessed the young Acharya with the deeksha title as "Satya Chandrashekarendra Saraswathi". It was a momentous and joyous occasion for the thousands of devotees across the temple campus and the pond - to have the darshan of both the Acharyas together. Chants of "Sri Shankara Vijayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamiji ki Jai" and "Sri Satya Chandrashekarendra Saraswathi Swamiji Shankaracharya ki Jai" filled the air. The Mangala Vadyams, and the spectacle of colourful fireworks added gaiety to the occasion.

Acharya Swamigal accompanied by Pujasri Satya Chandrashekarendra Saraswathi Swamiji proceeded to the main sanctum of Sri Kamakshi Ambal Temple, where visesha pujas were performed, followed by pujas and offering of Parivattams and prasadams at Jagadguru Adi Shankaracharya Sannidhi.

Both Acharyas walked in procession from the temple to Sri Shankara Math, accompanied by a large number of devotees, and with poornakumbhams and swagatam being offered enroute. At Shrimatam, after Sri Chandramouliswara Swami Puja darshan and prayers at the Adhistanams of Pujareshri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi Mahaswamiji and Pujareshri Jayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamigal, prasadams from various adhistanams of Purvacharyas, and from temples of Tamilnadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, and other states were offered by priests and representatives.

The Governor of Tamilnadu Sri RN Ravi and the First Lady, Chief Justice of Madras High Court Sri K R Shiram, Former MP Sri Subramanian Swamy and various eminent persons from different walks of life participated. Devotees from across the globe witnessed the events. Live webcast and broadcast in various Media enabled virtual darshan for those who could not make it in person.

Annadanam and distribution of water and buttermilk was performed at various places around the Raja Veedhis in addition to the Annadana Hall, and other venues.

Coinciding with the 2534th Shankara Jayanti Mahotsavam being held at Kanchipuram, this glorious event is an important milestone in the illustrious lineage of Shri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam, Kanchipuram.






