





Message from Acharya Swamigal to NRI Devotees



Message of Blessings

गुरुर्नाम्ना महिम्ना च शंकरो यो विराजते। तदीयाङ्घ्रिगलद्रेण्कणायास्त् नमो मम॥

The Nama & Mahima of Shankara Bhagavatapada is prescribed in this benediction. The second half of the shloka follows with special prostrations to the minutest particle of dust emerging from his holy feet. The veneration of the author is understood by his Namaskars to the holy dust of Guru's feet. There is a small chapter in a publication named 'Acharya Prashasti' where in shlokas dedicated to Shankara Bhagavatpada has been compiled from various books & authors and printed with the blessings of Kanchi Acharyas.

There is an ancient saying प्रत्यक्षे गुरवः स्तुत्याः - Benedictions to Guru can be done right in their presence. This is because a Guru is ever established in divine communion and seldom has any ego. And by Guru Anugraha, one's ignorance gets dispelled, the Ahamkara melts and mind gets purified.

गुरुं प्रकाशयेत् धीमान् is another Shastric saying. The substance of the saying is that a learned person extolls his Guru. This tradition of respecting Guru is one of the unique features of Sanatana Vaidika Hindu Dharma. This is one of the reasons that can be listed as significant, that, inspite of several struggles somehow the Bharatiya Vidyas could be protected. We can note that any knowledge system does not begin without benedictions to Guru. Shri Gurubhyo Namaha HariH Om is how Vedic traditions across Bharat commences Vedic chanting. Likewise other arts, skills commence with a set of shlokas dedicated to the originators of the respective Vidyas.

The Kanchi Math has promulgated and implemented the traditional Niyama Adhyayana scheme in Vedic learning where the father is the Guru and the son is the pupil and knowledge is transferred generation by generation so as to protect & uphold the purest form of Vedic traditions. This type can also be observed in Ayurveda, music, dance and other skills too. Knowledge in India has been dispensed to one & all as a means for development of merit, progress and service in society.

In the Upanishads we see pupils humbly prostrating saying नमः परमऋषिभ्यो नमः परमऋषिभ्यः to those who imparted them Para Vidya, the knowledge of the Ultimate, the Parabrahman. Shankarabhagavatpada with his great compassion blessed us by giving the Bhashyas of Vedanta and a tradition to continue his work. It is our fortune to be associated with the Guru Parampara of the Jagadguru.

Coming back to the shloka at the start, it is a composition of Kanchi Mahaswamy on Shankara Bhagavatpadacharya. This shloka helps up to understand & cherish the glory of the Jagadguru and of the Guru Parampara.



In the erstwhile Thanjavur District, the unique tradition of celebrating Skandar Sashti by inviting bramacharis to homes is at risk of extinction. To preserve this cultural heritage and uphold Sanathana Dharmam, it was revived in 2019 with the blessings of PujyaSri Sankaracharya Swamigal of Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam Samsthan.

With the aim of instilling tradition and culture in young minds, Sri. Sankaracharya Swamigal encourages all Brahmacharis under 21 in patasalas, schools, and colleges to prepare and participate in Skandar Sashti celebrations. They gather in a common venue, where they are warmly welcomed and treated as embodiments of Lord Subramaniyar Swami. After their daily rituals, they are ritually installed with dhyana, aavahana, aasana, and other rituals. They then recite Sri. Subramaniya Bhujangam and Skandar Sashti Kavacham together, followed by traditional pujas and offerings to Lord Subramnia Swami's portrait. The ceremony concludes with Maha parasadam distribution to Brahmacharis and attendees.

Sri. Subramaniya Bujangam, composed by Sri Adi Sankaracharya in praise of Lord Subramaniaya, holds the power to bring wisdom, clarity, good health, and protection when recited daily. Similarly, Skandha Sashti Kavacham shields us from dangers. Reciting both on Skandar Sashti Day multiplies their divine benefits.

Since 2019, Skandar Sashti celebrations began grandly in Chennai with over 1000 boys. Due to Covid regulations, we adopted a decentralized approach from 2020, celebrating in multiple centres across India. Starting next year, this annual event will occur on Skanda Shasti day in all designated centres, with participation steadily growing. Last year, we had nearly 2000 boys joining from India (Kasi to Rameshwaram) and abroad (Singapore, UAE & USA).

This year's Skandar Sashti is on 18th Nov 2023, following the Thanjavur District's tradition. With Sri Periyava's blessings, we aim for a global Skandar Sashti 2023, expanding to more centres worldwide with cooperation from our diaspora, including New Zealand, Australia, Qatar, and Great Britain. The goal is to have continuous chanting of Sri Subramaniya Bhujagam and Skandar Sashti Kavacham for 24 hours, aligning with local time zones. While we'll provide Veshtis and towels to some centers, we request others to arrange them locally, and international centers are encouraged to manage their celebration expenses locally.

This circular letter requests previous celebration organizers to confirm their participation in Skandar Sashti 2023 via email by 15-10-23, providing details like estimated participant numbers. It is also an invitation to new groups and individuals worldwide. Core organizers are urged to share this letter with potential participants, emphasizing the preservation of our culture. A list of last year's centers, last year agenda for the event, general instructions to participants is available in the link given in the QR code, and any updates should be promptly communicated. 

3-day Harikeertan concludes- Kashi Maharashtra Seva samiti presents Abhinandan patra to Acharya Swamigal

The 3-day - Harikeertan by Sri Raghunathdas as part of the Chaturmasya Sangeeta Samarpan programme culminated this evening in a session held at the Chet Singh fort on the banks of the river ganga in the benign presence of Acharya Swamigal. Sri Raghunathdas and team were given prasadams and honoured with shawls. Members of the Kashi Maharashtra Seva samiti and other members of Maharashtra community of Varanasi attended the programme in large numbers and presented abhinandan patra to Acharya Swamigal. In the Anugraha Bhashanam given to the gathering, Acharya Swamigal mentioned that











languages are for forming bridges, and not for forming barriers among people. The human year consisting of 365 days is considered to be a day for devas. Dakshinayana (from Tamil month Aadi to the end of Margazhi) is night for the devas and Uttarayana (from Tamil month Thai to the end of Aani) is daytime for them.

Adi Perukku (18th day of the Tamil month of Adi) - Cauvery puja was performed at Shivala ghat.

According to the South Indian tradition, even if one is not residing on the banks of the river Cauvery, one can go to a nearby water body (river, pond, temple tank, lake etc), invoke the divine river in it and perform Puja. Cauvery Ashtottaram, Lakshmi Ashtottaram Archana is performed followed by Shodashopacharam, Naivedyam & Deeparadhana. As per the above custom, Pundits of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam perform special pujas every year in the place of camp of Acharya Swamigal.

The pundits accompanied by devotees went to the Shivala ghat on the banks of Ganga and performed Cauvery pooja. Kalasham filled with holy water was brought to Srimatam and offered to Acharya Swamigal. Being the Jayanti day of Pujya Shri Jayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamigal, a portrait of Pujya Swamigal was also taken in procession.

Special Naivedyaprasadams were distributed on the occasion.

With blessings of Acharya Swamigal, Adi Perukku was also celebrated at Kanchipuram in the Pancha Ganga teertham in Sri Kamakshi Ambal Devasthanam, and at various places on the banks of the river Cauvery in Tamilnadu.




Annual Agnihotra Sabha held at Varanasi (06-Aug-2023)

With the benign blessings of Acharya Swamigal, the annual Agnihotri Sabha was held at Varanasi Kshetram from 5th till 7th. A very special Sanman Sabha was held at the Sabha venue at Chet Singh Fort grounds. Sarsanghchalak of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh Sri Mohan Bhagavat Ji took part in the proceedings. Sri Bhagavatji was received by Kanchi Math officials & devotees in Ganga-front. After Darshan of Acharya Swamigal, he had darshan of Agnihotra Vedi, Kamyeshti Vedi, Panchangni Vedi where special Anushthanams were performed with the blessings of Acharya Swamigal for Loka-Kashema. The Yagnya Vedi vibrated with Rig Veda Shastra Parayan, Yajur Veda Ghana Parayanam and Samaveda Shastra Parayanam. Viewing the Agnihotri Exhibition, Acharya Swamigal explained to Sri Bhagavatji the various Vedic practices and traditions which are prevailing in our country since ancient times.

Two books on Bhashyas of Ashvalayana Gruhya Sutra & Apastamba Gruhya Sutra authored by Brahmasri Sundarrama Vajapeyayaji and his son Sri Narayana Vajapeyayajee were released on the occasion. Acharya Swamigal released the books and Sri Bhagavatji received them. Sri Prabhakar Joglekar was given the Ashvalayana Shrouta Sutra Bhashya and Sri Kashi Narayana Ghanapathi was given the Apastamba Shrouta Sutra Bhashya book. Also books on culture & traditions were released during the function.

Following this Sarsanghchalak Sri Mohan Bhagavatji spoke on Vedic & Agnihotri traditions as India's treasures and that it should be protected. Sri Bhagavatji said that these are seeds of Dharma and they should be nurtured. Acharya Swamigal in his Anugraha Bhashanam spoke about the expanse of Agnihotra traditions beyond India's borders in ancient times. Acharya Swamigal said while India has achieved independence and is developing, we should also develop Dharmic thoughts and protect our ancient culture & traditions. Acharya Swamigal mentioned about Digital India and stressed the need to develop Divine India. Acharya Swamigal talked about protecting temple, temple traditions and temple assets. Temple donations should be used only for Dharmic work, He stressed. Acharya Swamigal said that Seva through Mantras "Mantron Se Manav Seva" is being done by the Agnihotris of our country. Acharya Swamigal said that there are such subjects in Sanātana Dharma which are deep and wide but needed presentation & distribution. He said this Dharma has both Vignan & Vishwas and prays for welfare of one & all.

About 120 Agnihotris & senior scholars from all over the country including Kerala, Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan participated in the event. In the divine presence of Acharya Swamigal, Sri Mohan Bhagavatji draped all the Agnihotris with special shawls and were honoured with gold coin, silver Patra, Vastram etc. Special dignitaries from Kashi city attended the event. Sri Girish Chandra Sharma Former Vice Chancellor, Sri Vajpayi MLA of Prayagraj and his parents, Agarwal Sangh, Pracharaks and devotees & common people attended the event. 
Acharya Swamigal blesses release of various Books on our Dharma and Culture (24-Aug-2023)

Acharya Swamigal visits Benaras Hindu University (03-Oct-2023)

Acharya Swamigal visited Benaras Hindu University on 3rd October in the evening. Acharya Swamigal was received by the entire Sanskrit Department led by Prof VK Shukla, Rector, BHU. Acharya Swamigal was welcomed by Shri Shukla and other professors submitted Swagata Abhinandanam to Acharya Swamigal. Prof Kamalesh Pandey read shlokas on Pujya Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamigal. Prof Dr. Rajaram Shukla read out the Hindi Translation of Speech by Pujya Shri Chandrashekharendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamigal delivered at BHU in 1934. Acharya Swamigal then addressed the gathering echoing the speech of Kanchi Mahaswamy and stressed its relevance in present times too.

Acharya Swamigal then released the 10th volume of Uttankita Vidyaranya Sanskrit Inscription series and blessed the first copy to Prof VK Shukla and rest to the department Professors. Acharya Swamigal traced the objectives of the Trust as to publishing Sanskrit inscriptions along with English translation to bring out the real history of our country. It may be recalled that the Trust commenced by Pujya Kanchi Mahaswamy in 1986 has been publishing books chronologically from 2th Century B.CE and the current edition covers 9th & 10th Century inscriptions. Acharya Swamigal said that he had reserved to release the book at BHU in the memory of Sri Kanchi Mahaswamy. After the first edition released in 1986 in the august presence of Kanchi Mahaswamy, Pujya Shri Jayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamigal & Acharya Swamigal have blessed and encouraged the trust in fulfilling its objectives.

Acharya Swamigal visits Ram Mandir and Sanga Veda Vidyalaya - A historic day (06-Oct-2023)

A historic event repeated yesterday when Acharya Swamigal visited Ram Mandir at Gaay Ghat & Vallabhram Shaligram Sanga Veda Vidyalaya at Ram Ghat, Varanasi. It was on the same date ninety years back on 6/10/1934 when HH Pujya Shri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi entered Varanasi and visited both these places. His Holiness Kanchi Mahaswamy had camped in these places for two weeks before arriving at the Shankar Math, Hanuman Ghat and stayed on for about 6 months. His Holiness Pujya Shri Jayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamigal visited Ram Mandir and Veda Pathashala during his first Pada Yatra visit to Varanasi in 1973 and subsequently had blessed the Pathashala many times during his subsequent Yatras.

Ram Mandir

The Ram Mandir is maintained by Punjabi Saraswat Brahmin Community since 150 years. The Mandir houses two shrines for Ram Darbar and Shiv Darbar. The Mandir is built in typical Kashi style with artistic pillars in stone holding the weight of the upper floors. It also has rare photographs of Kanchi Mahaswamy and photos of various Devi Devathas printed at Karachi & Lahore. The community members led by Sri Abhayram Sand, who are maintaining the Mandir said to Acharya Swamigal that there were about a few thousand members who had migrated to Varanasi from West Punjab (Lahore, Karachi) from Undivided India. There were great scholars from the community who guided the Hindus of Punjab in their religious and societal obligations. They said that it was their fortune to host Kanchi Mahaswamy, Pujya Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Swami and now Acharya Swamigal in their Mandir. They recalled that Kanchi Mahaswami had stayed in Ram Mandir with Sri Chandramouleeshwara Swamy Puja for two weeks and the ground opposite to the Mandir was used to house Srimatam Elephants, Camels, cows and bullock carts. Special Harathi was performed in the Mandir and Acharya Swamigal blessed the caretaker family with shawls & Prasadam.

Vallabhram Shaligram Sanga Veda Vidyalaya

Acharya Swamigal then started to Sanga Veda Vidyalaya. The Pathashala could be reached only by walking in the long and narrow lanes, typical to be seen and experienced in Varanasi. Acharya Swamigal walked through them and reached the Pathashala. People Enroute had Darshan. Acharya Swamigal was received by Sri Ganeshwar Sastry Dravid and Pathashala Adhyapakas. Babban Lakshman Maske, Member, Sri Lakshmikanth Dikshit ji, Jagannatha Sastry Tailang, Sudhamshu ji, Krishnagopal Sharma and other Adhyapaks were present during Acharya Swamigal's visit.

Sri Ganeshwar Sastry Dravid read Swagatham and listed the important events held in the Pathashala in the past years which included visit of Kanchi Mahaswamy Pujya Shri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamigal, Pujya Shri Jayendra Saraswathi Shankaracharya Swamigal & Acharya Swamigal. Prof Dr. Sri Rajaram Shukla & Sri Sharma, Chief of NDRF, Varanasi were chief guests on the occasion. The Swagathabhivandanam continued with a set of beautiful verses composed in the greatness of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam and its Acharyas. Later Sri Vishweshwar Shastry Dravid performed Pada Puja to Acharya Swamigal.

In his Anugraha Bhashanam, Acharya Swamigal commended the work of Sanga Veda Vidyalaya in imparting Vedas along with its branches and with Sadacharam. Acharya Swamigal said that the Pathashala was endowed with great Vidwans in the past & present and is continuing to fulfilling its foundational objectives. Acharya Swamigal described the Pathashala as a heritage Pathashala due to its Vedic & Shastri legacy and its iconic structure too. Acharya Swamigal said that the Pathashala was established with a sense of sacrifice by munificient donors, some of whom were Vedic scholars who gave up their entire belongings. Acharya Swamigal said that people should get together and support such Pathashalas and protect Vedic heritage. Acharya Swamigal said that the problems faced by the Pathashala should get solved at the earliest and function in its fullest glory. Acharya Swamigal concluded the speech with blessing the Adhyapaks, Vidyarthis & members and chanted Totakashtakam. Prasadams blessed by Acharya Swamigal were distributed to the assembled.

Acharya Swamigal then walked through the lanes to reach Ganesh Ghat from where Srimatam entourage returned to Hanuman Ghat through ferry which reduced travel time by 45 mins. Embarking at Shivala Ghat, Acharya Swamigal returned back to Math and performed Shukaravara Puja which commenced at 9:45 PM and concluded at 12:30 post midnight.

Generally, visits are not fixed for Acharya Swamigal on Fridays due to Abhishekam Pujas in the evening too. As it was a historic date, Acharya Swamigal attended the visits to commemorate the occasion. Leaving Srimatam Camp at 5:30 PM after giving darshan, Acharya Swamigal returned back at 9:15 PM and immediately went for Puja.

Acharya Swamigal had first visited the Pathashala in 1988. At that time Acharya Swamigal had accompanied Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Swamiji to Nepal Yatra and on return stayed in Varanasi.

<u>Devotee's experience – contributed by Sri. K. Guruvayurappan</u>

70, 70, 70 and 70 – 50 Years of Divine Experience Celebration with HH at Varanasi Camp!

It was early to mid-70's that I was blessed by Their Holiness Sri Maha Perivaa in Thenampakkam and by Sri (Pudu) Perivaa in Varanasi for my bright future in USA and to get involved with Sri Matam activities (which I didn't know at that time)!

HH Sri Maha Perivaa Darshan at Thenambakkam — During my audit of Sri Rama Café (a very famous hotel with Boarding and Lodging in early 70's before many of the new ones that have come recently), I went for Darshan of HH Sri Maha Perivaa in the morning. My auditor Sri C.S. Hariharan's wife was also present there and introduced me to HH. HH while asking Mami about the details of how the Sapthaham of Sri Haridoss Swamigal went in her house that was just ended a few days before that day. During the conversation between HH and Mami, I got answers for my audit queries I have in mind which were not still convincingly replied by Sri Rama Café. Through this conversation, HH made it clear for the query and sort of taught me accounting and auditing to a Bachelor of Science doing CA!

HH Sri Pudu Perivaa Darshan at Sri Kamakoteeswari Sametha Sri Kamakoteeswarar Temple in

Varanasi: Continuing in the 70's during Navarathri time after the Kumbhabishekam of the temple HH was camping with Sri Chandramouleeswarar Puja. While my parents went to Gaya as part of Pithru Karyams, they left me to stay with Sri Viswanatha Sastrigal of Swamimalai. My younger sister and I will go for puja daily and used to admire how one of the ardent devotees of Sri Matam – Sri Rajamani Mama (who was one of the core team members of HH Varanasi Camp) was called by HH every second to do this and to do that. I used to wonder how lucky Mama was and wished that how nice it would be if we do service to Sri Matam and Perivaas like Rajamani mama. One day, HH connected me to Rajamani mama and asked him to take me to his office and show. I had no idea but thought I was lucky (and later only realized how Blessed and wondered whether it was the Pillayar Suzhi for my US migration after a decade from then) to have a grand tour of Rajamani mama's office which is US Embassy in Chanakyapuri, New Delhi. Rajamani Mama after giving a very nice tour introduced me to Sri Srinivasan who is the last son of Swamimalai Sri Viswanatha Sastrigal who was settled in Varanasi. The first two sons of Sastrigal mama were in Vaideekam – Sri Ramasesha Ganapadigal and Sri Krsihnamurthy Ganapadigal. Both sons who were in the vaideekam are no more and Srinivasan Mama moved to USA. Rajamani mama and his wife are no more and their son Sri Krishnakumar (Supreme Court attorney) and daughter Rhama Mami are settled in New Delhi.

When both the above episodes happened in the early to mid-70's I was still doing my CA and I didn't even apply for the Passport during the two Darshans. I got the passport in the late 70's after the emergency was over and my passport application was signed by Sri Kumari Anandan, MP at that time.

We were blessed to go with our family to HH 2023 Chaturmasyam Camp in Varanasi and stayed in Varanasi for three weeks. During our Darshan with other New Jerseyans who accompanied us (Sri Muthuswamy Govindarajan, came to India after 17 years and Smt. Chandra Muthuswamy), we offered Tiruttani Prasadams and shared the Nostalgic Memories of photos from 1998 Chaturmasyam at Secunderabad – 25th Silver Jubilee Year this year in Varnasi 2023. The common factor in both these years was that on both these Chaturmasyams – the Vyasa Puja was done on one day and Chatur Masya Sankalpam was done on another day at a different Kshetra. We conveyed HH that during our stay apart from my 70th Janmadhin we will be blessed to take part in 89th Jayanthi of HH Sri Jayendra Perivaa.



The Gurukula system back in the olden days was mainly focussed in imparting learning to the students as well as the society, the meaning, excellence and essence of Dharma. Kacheris, Nama Sankeertanams, pravachanams were organised in villages with the aim of bringing the awareness of our Sanatana Dharma, the knowledge that ever exists.

Some people adopted Uncchavritti as a means to propagate and promote various musical compositions which themselves have a deeper expression of our Dharma. Musicians go around the streets rendering Tyagaraja kritis while also collecting alms from the people which is called as Bhikshaatana purvaka Sangeeta utsavam.

Sri Mulasthaneshwara swamy temple is a very old Shiva temple located in the city of Nellore. Generally moolasthanam means the Garbhalayam (sanctum sanctorum) of any temple. As the name implies, we all have to

emphasize and focus on this moolasthanam by protecting, preserving and propagating our moola mantram, moola dharmam. Dharma moolam (knowing our roots).



The moolasthanam for our dharma are our Vedas, Upanishads, Puranas, Vigraha Aradhana, Nitya Karmanushtanam etc. Tilakadhaarana by every Hindu with either kumkum, chandan or Tiruman. Daivi shakti (Divine energy) into our homes also have to be practiced by all.

Sanatana dharma and nurturing and protecting ecology go hand in hand. We believe nature is holy and to be respected and hence we worship holy rivers and holy trees like Ashwatta, Audumbara, Bilva etc. While Natural resources can be utilised by humans, we believe in conserving them and not exploiting them. Protecting the environment is an important expression of our dharma. ব্যাব্য তাগায়াখা, বক্লবাত Our dharma is the one that has seen the divinity not only in all human beings but also in the entire creation that consists of both movable and immovable beings.

Pudu Periyava Jeyanthi was celebrated on 3-8-2023 with pravachanam by Shri Kannan mama




